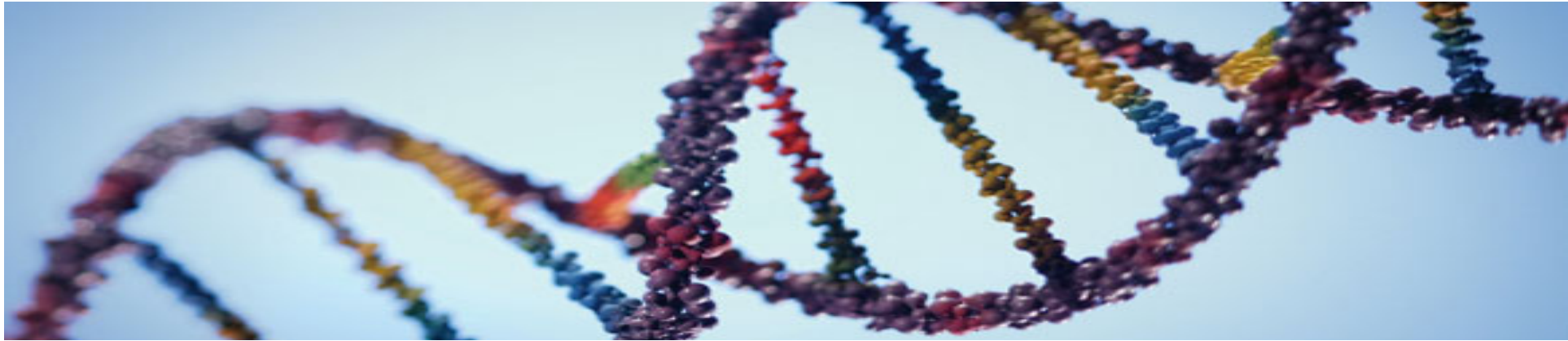


Genetic Counseling Student Interest Group (GC SIG) @ Stanford
