## **Packard Quality Management Systems (PQMS) training**

As part of the QI/PI scholarly concentration you should participate in Packard Leader Training. This is a 3 day course that exposes the learner to various LEAN principles and methodologies as they are applied to healthcare. The course focuses on the application of these principles at Lucile Packard Children's Hospital Stanford and Stanford Children's Health. In order to participate in the course you must first complete the one day basic introduction to PQMS.

### **Step 1**

Register for PQMS Foundations

This is a one day course that you can take at any time.
