

GPCHC IMMUNIZATION SCHEDULE

Birth	HepB
2 months	Vaxelis, PCV, Rotavirus
4 months	Vaxelis, PCV, Rotavirus
6 months	Vaxelis, PCV, Rotavirus
12 months	MMR, Varicella, HepA
15 months	DTap, Hib, PCV
18 months	HepA
4-6 years	Proquad (MMRV), Kinrix (DTap/IPV)
11-12 years	Tdap, MCV4*, HPV9**
16 years	MCV4* and MenB*

Combo vaccines:

- Vaxelis (DTap, HepB, IPV, Hib): ages 6 wks- 4 yrs old (give prior to 5th birthday)
- Proquad (MMRV): ages 4-12 yrs old, as long as no personal or FHx of seizures and no other live vaccines within 30 days.
- Kinrix (DTap, IPV): ages 4-6 yrs old

Rotavirus: GPCHC uses RV5 (Rotateq), total of 3 doses

* Meningococcal vaccines

- MCV4: strains ACWY, 2 doses
- MenB: strain B, 2 doses (0, 1-2 months). (Not needed until age 16. OCHIN is not flagging when due.)

**HPV9

- If starting at 9-14 years, 2 doses (minimum 6 months apart)
 - If 2 doses given less than 5 months apart, 3rd dose required (0, 1-2, 6 months)
- If starting at 15 years or older, 3 doses (0, 1-2, 6 months)

Live vaccines are listed above in **bold**.
