

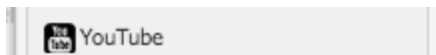
YouTube Player Component

Description of Component

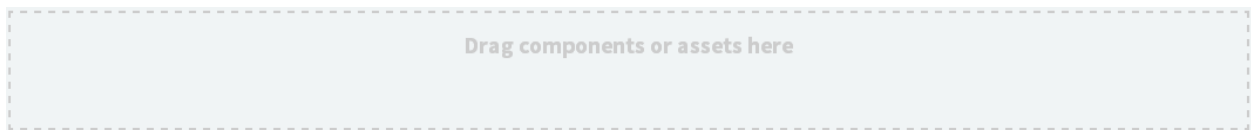
The YouTube Player component is used to display a YouTube video on a web page (from the Stanford Medicine YouTube channel or other related content channel) that visitors can click on to watch YouTube videos on your website.

How to Use the Component

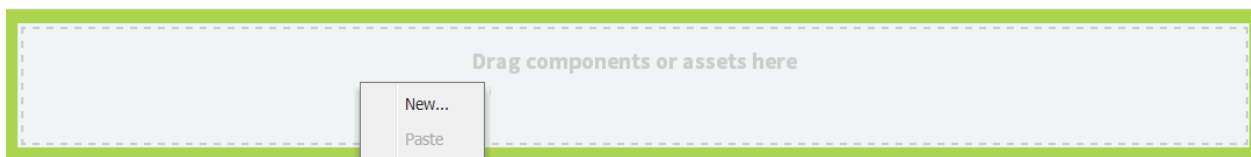
1. You can identify the YouTube player component in the Web Author toolkit as follows:




2. Drag the component onto the page in the place where you want the text to display.



3. Or, right click and select New.



4. Right click or double click to open the component to edit it.




