TIPS FOR CHOOSING A SUMMER CAMP

Ask your child about their interest.

- What does she/he want to do this summer?
- What new things would he/she like to accomplish?

Decide if you want your child to attend with a friend, cousin, or siblings.

- Who is your child's friend at The Primary School?
- Are there any family members who want to enroll their child in a camp?

Think about the logistics of camp.

- Do you want a camp in East Palo Alto/Belle Haven or in another city?
- Do you need full day or half day? How many weeks do you need camp?

Think about cost of camp - more tips below!

- What can you afford? What family or friend can help?

TIPS FOR PAYING FOR SUMMER CAMP

Use your Flexible Spending Account (FSA) to pay for camp.

If you elected to save some money in a [Flexible Spending Account \(FSA\)](#) through your employer, you may be surprised to know that you can use that fund for certain types of summer camp. Talk with your employers Human Resources Department.

Use the Child & Dependent Care Credit to reduce your camp costs.

Like the FSA, the Child and Dependent Care Credit gives parents a tax break when they need to pay for child care so they can work. Eligible children must be under 13, live with you for more than six months each year, and depend on you for more than half of their support. This credit will help you at tax time by reducing the amount of money you pay in federal taxes dollar-for-dollar.

Trim the cost of summer camp cost

- Ask for sibling discounts
- Apply early to get early bird discounts
- Ask friends or family to babysit based on your budget

Open a Savings Account for Summer Expenses with your local bank or San Mateo Credit Union and put money away in advance.

Save your tax refund check and put it in a savings account to pay for camp!

Apply for financial aid or scholarships at local and nearby camps.
