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Trained in public health policy and management, Ms. Baer is the Director of ECHO Research & Education and Lead Health Coach for ECHO Diabetes, and the Director of Education for ECHO Diabetes in the Time of COVID-19 series, in the Department of Pediatrics and Division of Endocrinology & Diabetes at Stanford University School of Medicine.
