Rayhan then completed an adult and pediatric endocrine fellowship at Stanford. He now works on autonomous (closed-loop) insulin delivery systems with his mentor, Dr. Bruce Buckingham. Dr. Lal collaborates with many members of the Stanford Diabetes Research Center, industry and open source diabetes community in an effort to bypass the biological, technological and human factor limitations of existing devices.
