

Are you allergic to multiple foods, including peanut?

If so, you may be eligible to take part in a clinical research study to learn more about an investigational treatment for people who are allergic to multiple foods, including peanut.

You may be eligible if:

- You are a male or female between the ages of 2 and 55 years old
- You have a peanut allergy, and an allergy to at least two of the following:
 - Milk, egg, wheat, cashew, hazelnut, or walnut

What's involved?

- Study visits to the clinic for up to four and a half years.
- Food challenges, skin prick testing, food allergen specific testing, lab sample collection
- Experimental study medication administration
