Background

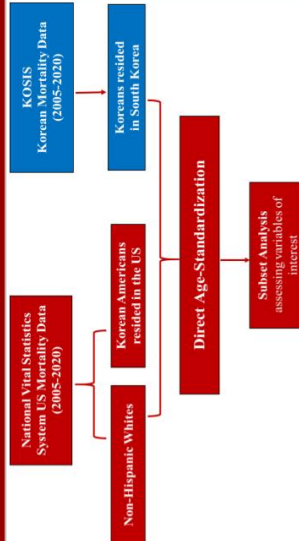
- ~2.6 million Koreans residing in the US

Objective

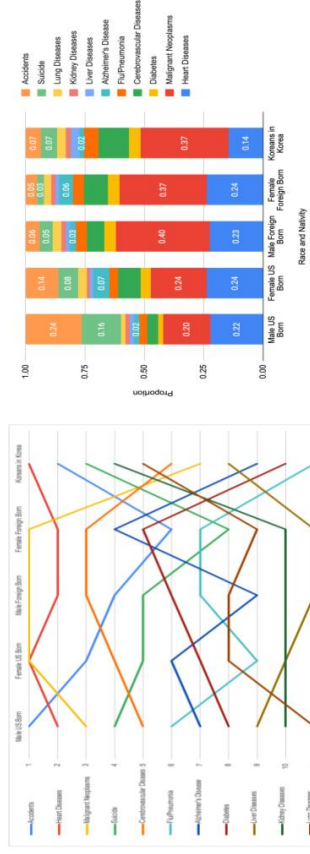
- To characterize the leading causes of death between Korean Americans and Koreans in Korea by nativity and sex

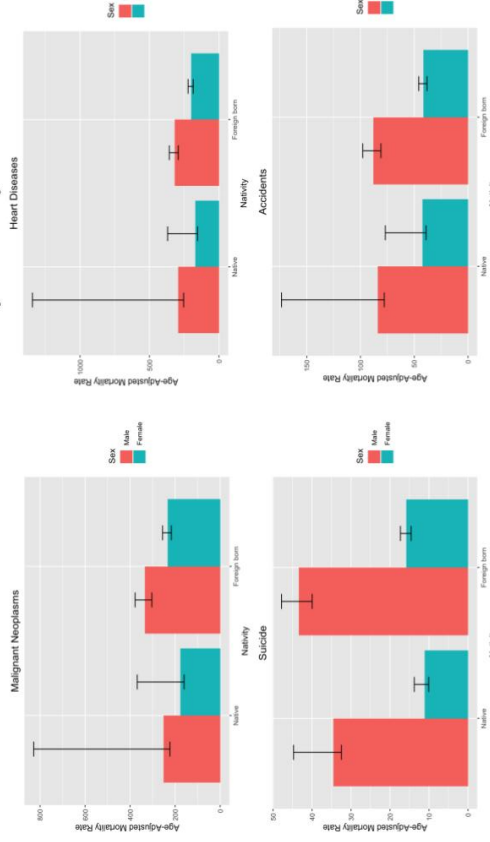

Leading Causes of Death in by Proportions Ranked

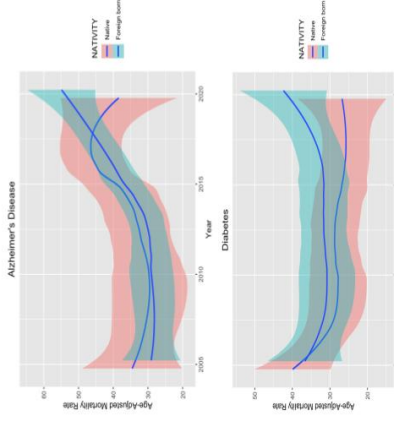


AAMR of Malignant Neoplasms, Heart Diseases, Suicide, and Accidents in Korean Americans by Nativity and Race



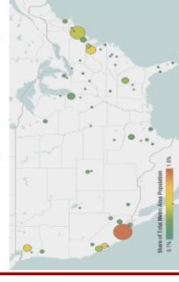
