

Vasopressin Treatment Trial for Children with Autism

Stanford University researchers are currently recruiting children with **autism spectrum disorder (ASD)** to participate in a research study which tests the effects of intranasal vasopressin on social functioning.

In order to participate in this research study your child must be:

- Diagnosed with an autism spectrum disorder (ASD)
- Between the ages of 6 and 17 years
- Willing to take a vasopressin or placebo nasal spray for at least 8 weeks and provide blood samples
- Willing to participate in behavioral and cognitive testing
- Free of serious medical problems

You will receive \$60 for the screening visit and \$30 for each additional visit. You will also receive generalized results regarding your child's cognitive and behavioral assessments.
