International Genetic Counseling Applicant Mentorship Program

The International Genetic Counseling Applicant Mentorship Program started in 2021 to consolidate, streamline, support, and expand existing mentorship efforts for international prospective GC students.

The program aims to help prospective international students:

- Improve awareness and understanding of the genetic counseling profession
- Prepare for genetic counseling graduate school applications and interviews
- Understand the complexities of being an international student in graduate school in the U.S.
- Navigate nuanced considerations about life in the U.S. as an international genetic counselor.

The mentorship program includes one-on-one and group components. Mentees may choose to participate in some or all of the following activities:

- One-on-one meetings between mentor and mentee
- Resume review
- Statement of Purpose review
- Mock interviews
- Social hours
- Webinars

There is no cost to participate in the mentorship program. All of our mentors are volunteers. We're a team of GCs passionate about international genetic counseling!
