1.	is the Site Director at the affiliate who agrees to administrative,	
	educational and supervisory responsibilities for the residents during the rotation at the affiliate, including	
	responsibility for teaching, supervision, and formal evaluation of the resident's performance during the rotations.	
2.	Competency based educational goals and objectives (attached) of the rotations are to provide a superior learning and	
	training experience in in a supervised educational hospital setting.	
3.	The faculty at must provide appropriate supervision of residents/fellows	
	in patient care activities and maintain a learning environment conducive to educating the residents/fellows in the	
	ACGME competency areas. The faculty must evaluate resident performance in a timely manner during each rotation	
	or similar educational assignment and document this evaluation at completion of the assignment.	
4.	The period of rotation is: Reimbursement for resident salaries and	
	benefits may be covered by the master affiliation agreement, if in effect.	
5.	The Site Director is responsible to notify the Program Director promptly, of any issue, clinical or academic, that may	
	seriously affect any Stanford Health Care resident.	
6.	Stanford Health Care's House Staff Policies and Procedures govern the policies and procedures for the resident's	
	education during rotations.
