Happy Healthy Bladder Study

Research focus: Elementary school children can develop issues with their bladders and urination as they transition from pre–K to the kindergarten and early elementary school years. Using a 45–to–60–minute focus group session, we aim to obtain provider perspectives regarding the attitudes and knowledge surrounding lower urinary tract health in these children and identify obstacles to mitigating the development of these disorders.
