Carl Streed Jr, MD, MPH, FACP is an Assistant Professor of Medicine in the Section of General Internal Medicine at Boston University School of Medicine and Research Lead in the Center for Transgender Medicine and Surgery at Boston Medical Center. He earned his medical degree from Johns Hopkins, where he advocated for the inclusion of Sexual Gender and Minority (SGM) health in the curricula of the Schools of Medicine, Nursing, and Public Health, increased visibility and value of SGM communities through community advocacy and achieved transgender equity in health insurance coverage. He completed a fellowship in General Internal Medicine at Brigham & Women’s Hospital where his research focused on the health and well-being of SGM individuals and communities, particularly transgender and gender non-conforming individuals.

Nationally, he has chaired the American Medical Association Advisory Committee on LGBTQ Issues and served on the board of GLMA: Health Professionals Advancing LGBTQ Equality. Carl’s efforts to improve the health and well-being of SGM individuals and communities have earned him several awards, notably from the University of Chicago Alumni Association, the American Medical Association Foundation, the World Professional Association for Transgender Health, as well as recognition from the Obama White House.
