LEADERSHIP IN HEALTH DISPARITIES PROGRAM

Our Program

The Leadership in Health Disparities Program (LHDP) evolved from the Stanford Medical School's Early Matriculation Program (EMP) that began in 1984 to promote academic careers in medicine among minority & disadvantaged medical students. Over the past decades, the EMP was successful in helping students achieve academic and leadership careers. Yet, because of the persistence of health inequities in the nation, the EMP evolved into the LHDP to create the next generation of physician leaders committed to addressing health disparities.

Summer Program & 2 Year Leadership Seminars

In the summer quarter prior to their first year of medical school. It is directed at initiating a successful medical and leadership career. Program includes a two-year leadership seminar series during the school year focused on increasing students' knowledge of health inequities, the roles of a physician leader, and their leadership challenges. We encourage students interested in careers addressing health inequities to consider the program.

The summer is comprised of an eight-week program that offers students the following activities:

- Introduction to population health disparities.
- · Meetings with medical and community health leaders on issues of health disparities.
- Weekly sessions on developing leadership skills in medicine and meetings with physician leaders.
- Exposure to research opportunities with Stanford faculty members.
- Introductory Anatomy course integrating concepts of basic science with clinical science.
- Introduction to Patient Care course designed to provide early hands on introduction to taking patient histories and conducting standardized patient exams.
- Interactions with medical students, residents and faculty interested in health inequities.



Program Finances for Summer Program

Stanford Medical School by May 24th.

Stanford medical students enroll for the summer quarter. Participants receive a research assistantship, which covers the research rate tuition and salary covering the estimated cost of living expenses for the eight-week program. The research assistantship in most instances offsets most, if not all, of the costs. Additional financial aid is not available and typically not required.
