Vasopressin research treatment trial in children with autism

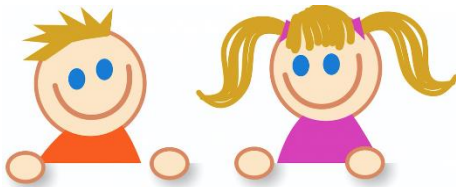
Stanford University researchers are currently recruiting children with autism spectrum disorder to participate in a research study which tests the effects of intranasal vasopressin on social functioning.



In order to participate in this research study your child must be:

- *Diagnosed with an autism spectrum disorder*
- *Between the ages of 6 and 17 years*
- *Willing to take a vasopressin or placebo nasal spray for at least 8 weeks and provide blood samples*
- *Willing to participate in behavioral and cognitive testing*
- *Free of serious medical problems*

You will receive \$60 for the screening visit and \$30 for each additional visit. You will also receive generalized results regarding your child's cognitive and behavioral assessments.
