



Important Information for Pediatric Cardiology Camp Attendees

Costs and Fees

- The costs of registration, meals, hotel (3 nights), simulation based equipment, and educational items will be provided at **NO COST** to you.
- If you are traveling from outside of the Bay Area, a hotel room in Palo Alto, California will be booked for you in your name for Friday, May 29, Saturday, May 30 and Sunday, May 31, 2020. If you would like to extend your hotel stay at the discounted rate you may do so but the boot camp will only be paying for the above nights.
- All meals will be provided free of charge at the conference center.

Flight Reimbursement

Research Component

Transportation:

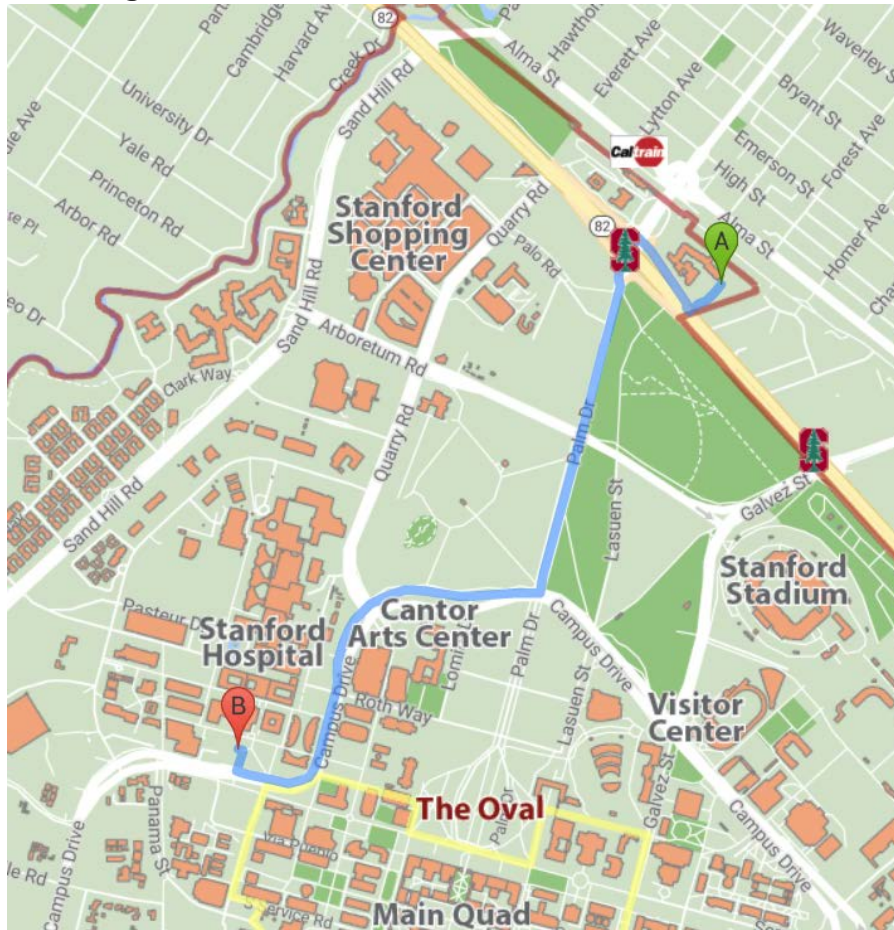
