TIP SHEET

MANDATED REPORTING

What Must be Reported:

Reasonable suspicion of any of the below acts involving anyone under the age of 18:

Physical Abuse, Sexual Abuse, Emotional Abuse & Neglect

Where to Report:

- Report Abuse to the child welfare agency in the <u>county of the child's residence</u>
- Report Crimes against children to the law enforcement agency where the crime occurred
- If uncertain where abuse occurred, contact local cps or law enforcement agency and they will either take report or assist you in locating the appropriate agency.

How to Report:

- ✓ By Phone: Immediately, or as soon as possible, make a telephone report
 to child welfare services and/or to a Police or Sheriff's department.
- Be prepared to provide your name, child's name, child's location, any
 information you have on the parent(s)/caregiver(s), the nature and
 extent of any injuries, and any information that led the team to suspect
 child abuse.
- Be sure to indicate the risks and impact on the child when you make report.
- Tip: Ask CPS where to fax or mail the written report when you're on the phone with them.
- ✓ In Writing: Within 36 hours of telephone report, a written report must be sent, faxed or submitted electronically to the County where you filed report. The written report should be completed on a state form called the 8572 (pictured) which can be found on the SCAN team's LPCH Intranet website.
