The Department of Psychiatry and Behavioral Sciences, Division of Sleep Medicine at Stanford University School of Medicine is seeking a full-time faculty member in the Clinician Educator Line, at the rank of Clinical Instructor or Clinical Assistant Professor, to conduct clinical care and teaching in behavioral sleep medicine. The position will be based in the Division of Sleep Medicine in the Department of Psychiatry and Behavioral Sciences.

The chosen candidate will serve as an attending psychologist in the Sleep Clinic, providing outpatient clinical care and sleep medicine consultative services to other departments. Teaching responsibilities will be fulfilled as part of regular clinical activities and will include supervision and didactics to postdoctoral fellows, medical students, residents, observers and other trainees. Clinical research opportunities are also available depending on interest.

Applicants must have a doctoral degree (PhD or PsyD) from an APA-accredited clinical psychology program and must have completed an APA-accredited internship in clinical psychology. Preference will be given to applicants having current California licensure and experience with evidence-based assessment and treatment in behavioral sleep medicine and health psychology, including behavior modification, cognitive-behavioral therapy, motivational enhancement, acceptance and commitment therapy, and/or mindfulness-based approaches.
