Teaching responsibilities will be fulfilled as part of the regular clinical activities, and include supervision and didactics to sleep medicine fellows, medical students, residents, fellows and other trainees.

Applicants must have a medical degree, must have completed training and be Board Certified in Sleep Medicine. Specialty training in pulmonary medicine, internal medicine, neurology, or psychiatry and possessing a current California medical license preferred.
