ADVANCE program

- Finally in person this summer!
- 10th year running

REACH post-baccalaureate program

- 1-2 year program for people who may not have lots of research experience but want to apply to graduate and medical schools
- Will include journal clubs, seminars, mini-courses, basic programming and stats courses, interview and application prep

REACH graduate fellowship and Biosciences Diversity Advocacy Council (BDAC)

- Each department nominates one admitted student for the REACH fellowship, and one “want to admit if had room” student for BDAC

Mentor/mentee ratios in Genetics

- Issue raised: Some faculty/labs have lots of graduate students while others have 0
- Some Genetics faculty want to balance the distribution of graduate students
 - Have a cap of “free” students for tenured faculty
 - No restriction for assistant profs
 - Tenured faculty over cap can take more, but contribute funds to central department pool that can theoretically be used to admit more students
 - Proposed cap: 6 Biosci or 4 Genetics students
- Biosciences is running a severe budget deficit
 - The four-year funding guarantee is no longer sustainable
