### Bio:

Dr. George Greer conducted over 100 therapeutic sessions with MDMA for 80 individuals from 1980 to 1985 with his psychiatric nurse wife, Requa Tolbert. He is a Distinguished Life Fellow of the American Psychiatric Association and Past President of the Psychiatric Medical Association of New Mexico. He was the Clinical Director of Mental Health Services for the New Mexico Corrections Department during the 1990s. He has been the Medical Director of the Heffter Research Institute since 1998 and is the current Board Chair.

### Abstract:

Dr. Greer will discuss some of his early work with MDMA therapy, survey the current landscape of psychedelic research, and share a “long view” of the field in light of four decades of involvement and leadership.
