

Would You Believe Activity

| <u>Purpose & Preparation</u> | <u>Procedure</u> |
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| <p>Purpose:</p> <p>Students will work in teams to compete by answering multiple choice questions about menthol cigarettes and its impact on the African American community.</p> <p>Preparation for <i>Option A</i>:</p> <p>Download and upload the presentation, "Would You Believe" PowerPoint.</p> <p>Materials Needed:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Computer ○ Projector ○ White Boards with Markers and Erasers for each team <i>(or teams can use any sheet of paper to write down answers)</i> <p><i>More directions below, please. Continue reading</i></p> | <p>Procedure:</p> <p><i>Option A:</i></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Break class into even teams (preferably groups of 5-10). 2. Teams will compete to correctly answer each question. 3. Assign a score keeper. 4. Start by reading each question aloud. 5. After the question is read, each team will confer with themselves to select the correct answer. 6. Each team will write the letter of their answer choice on their white board. 7. When all teams have answered, click to reveal the correct answer. 8. Have score keeper tally which teams got the answer correct. 9. Repeat procedure for all questions. 10. Wrap-up activity by asking students to discuss their thoughts and take-aways from this activity. <p><i>Option B:</i> The following version of this activity is if you are interested in utilizing Kahoot!</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Break class into even teams <i>(preferably groups of 5-10)</i>. 2. Pass out one worksheet to each team. <p><i>More directions below, please continue reading</i></p> |



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Preparation for Option B:

Print out the Menthol Kahoot! Worksheets (*one per team*).

Option B Continued:

3. Give the class enough time to answer all the questions on the worksheet with their team.
 - a. *Note: This can be a good time for you to set up Kahoot! on the projector if you did not do so before the activity started. Remember to select "Team Mode" not the "Classic" Mode.*
4. (*Roughly 5 minutes later*) Once all teams have finished, ask one member of each team to use a device to log into Kahoot!
5. Once each team is logged in, begin your Kahoot!
 - a. *Note: Remind students that Kahoot! is not only a game of choosing the right answers but speed! This should be easy as they had time to discuss each question before the game.*
6. As each question appears, read it out loud to the class.
7. Let each team make a choice. Once the time is up, the correct answer will appear.
8. You can discuss each answer with the class before moving on to the next question.
9. Repeat steps 6-8 for each question.
10. At the end, Kahoot! will display the winning team that answered the quickest with the most questions right.
11. Wrap up the activity by asking students to discuss their thoughts and take-aways from this activity.
