

Heading

Headings add titles that define and segment content, a bit like a webpage table of contents. They can even be used for navigation by enabling anchor links. They're also very useful for elevating your site search results by using keywords within.

Features

- Multiple styles and color
- Subheading text
- Hyperlink option
- Anchor option

Title, segment, organize and navigate page content



Standard Style

Serif, underlined | Link option turns heading blue



Simple Style

Sans serif | All samples H2 | Red color option



Block Style

High contrast | Black color option | Anchor option: `<#block-style>`



Pro Tips

- Use only 1 H1 per page
- Nest H2s & H3s in a hierarchical fashion
- Be consistent with styles across pages
- Use with Anchor Menu component for intra-page navigation
