


# Image

Image components quite simply add stand-alone imagery within your webpage. With a full suite of configuration options, use visuals to color your site with images from the Asset Manager.

## Features

- Imagery or icons
- Crop tool
- Captions
- Alignment & widths
- Hyperlink
- Fullscreen (modal) mode

## Pro Tips

- Use the "wrap text" (float) function to surround your image with words
- Use with purpose – captions can help with this
- Consider using the Text & Image component for easy preformats
- Always upload files to the Asset Manager first – do not insert from desktop
- Enable fullscreen mode for images with text
