

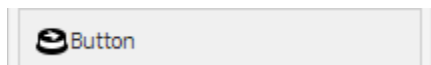
Button Component

Description of Component

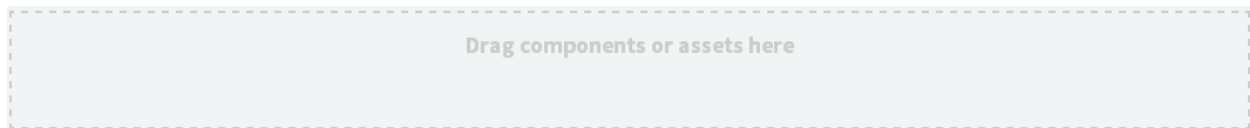
The Button component is used to add clickable and customized links to a web page. With the ability to choose a button style from a list of choices, this component adds visually pleasing styling to links on a web page. Optional features include the choice of highlight color, alignment options, an icon to display with the link, and open in a new window and allowing search engines to follow the link.

How to Use the Component

1. You can identify the Button component in the Web Author toolkit as follows:



2. Drag the component onto the page in the place where you want the text to display.




3. Or, right click and select New.



4. The component displays on the web page.

5. Double click or right click to open the component.

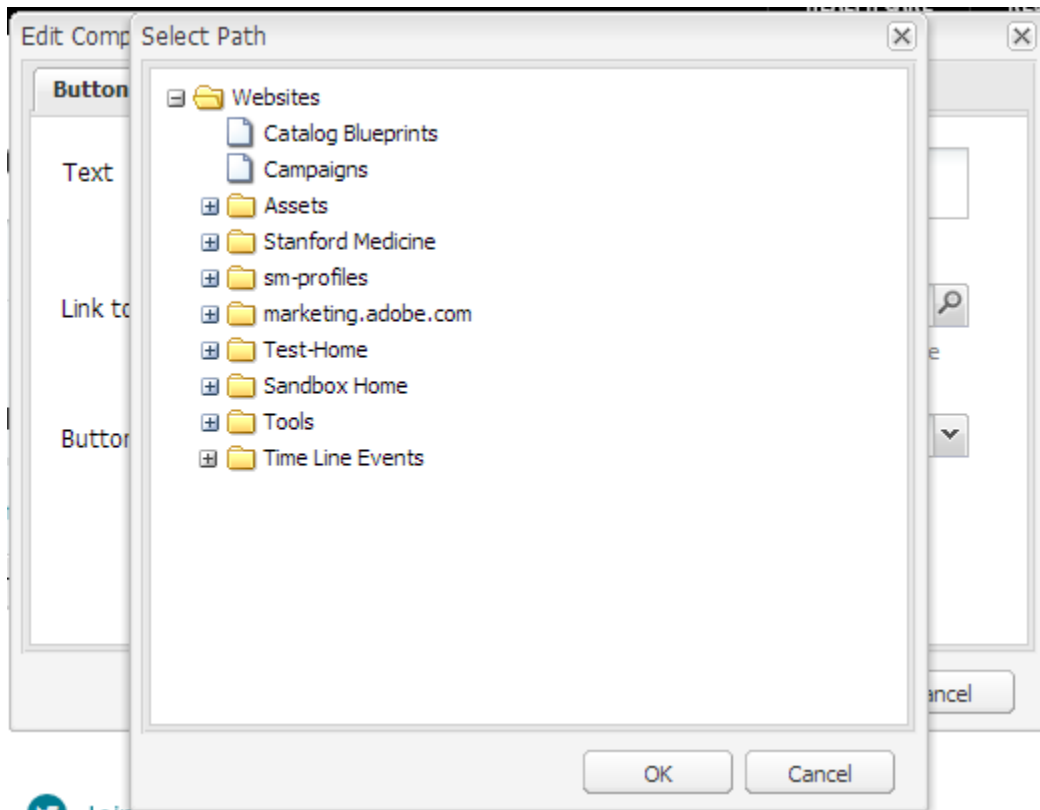

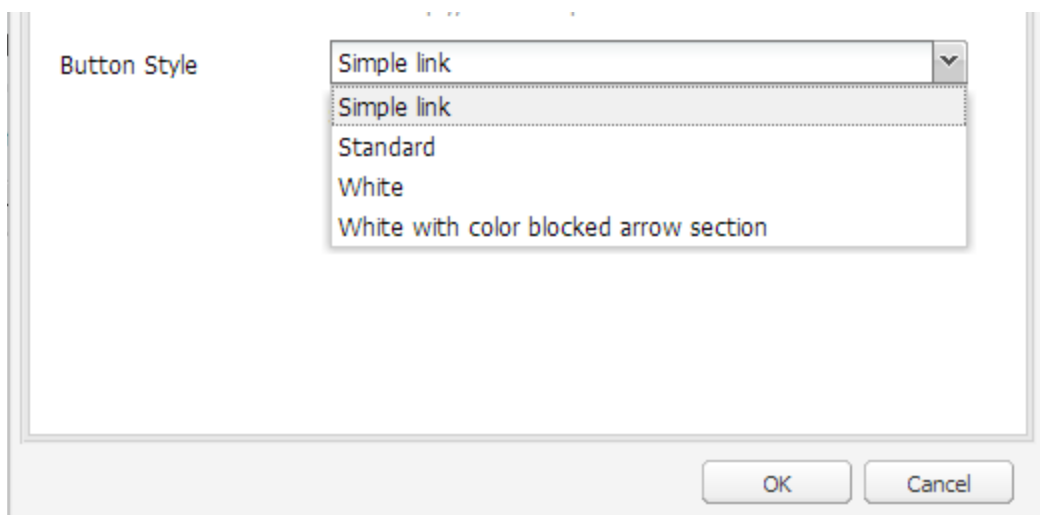

6. Enter text in the field.


7. Enter a link by either clicking the magnifying glass and selecting the path or by using the correct external link format.



8. Choose a button style from the dropdown.

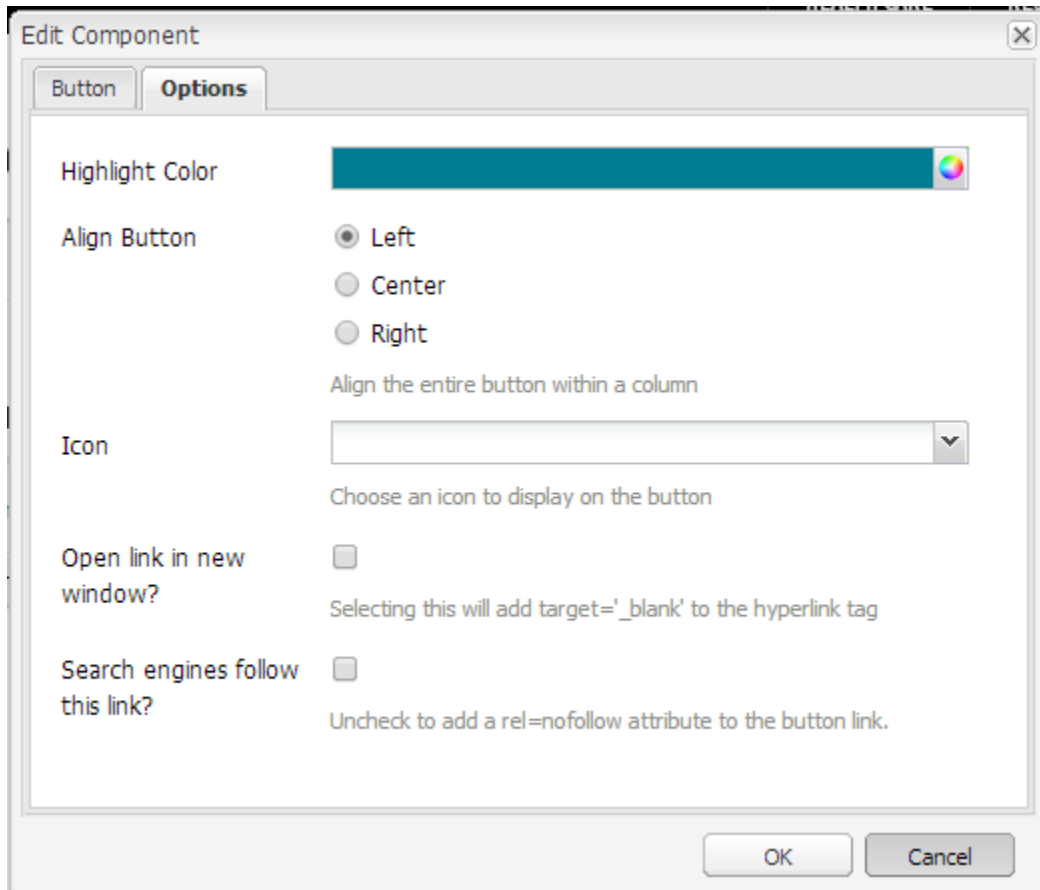

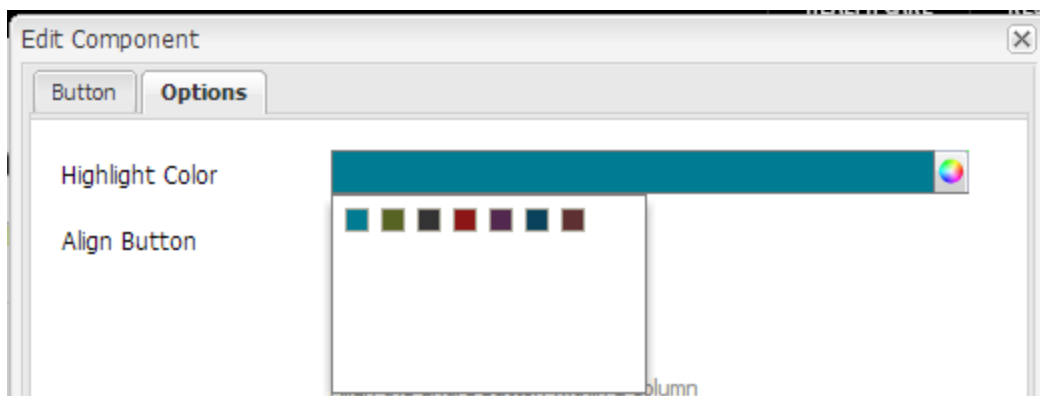

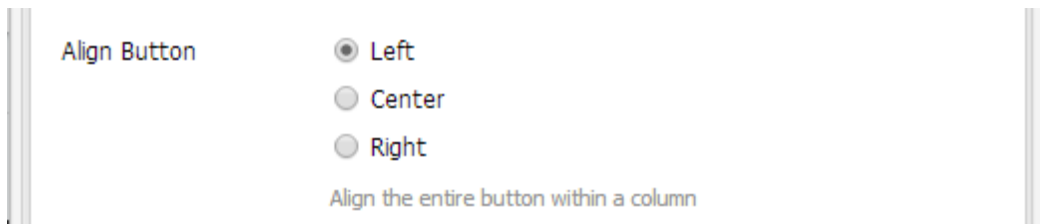
9. Click on the options tab to add optional functionality.



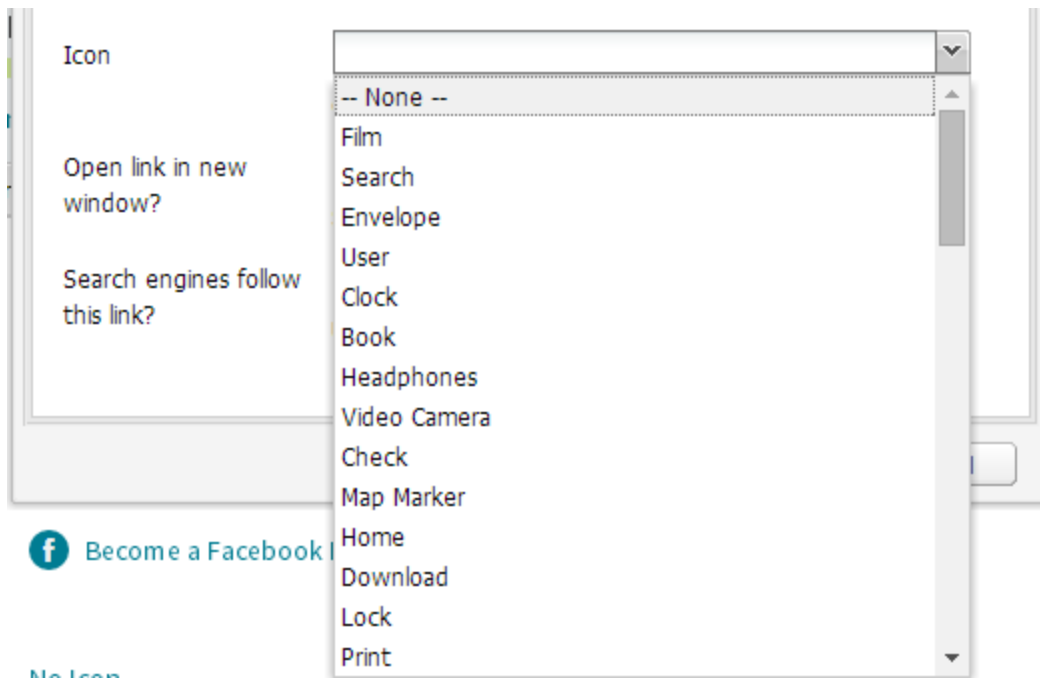
10. Choose a color to highlight the link.



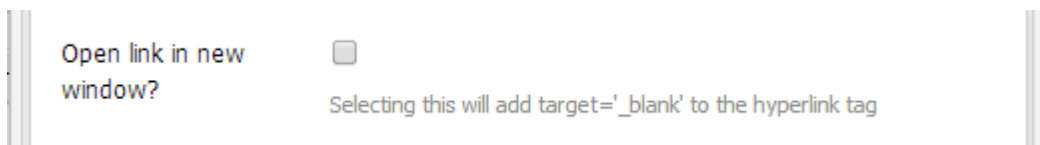
11. Choose the alignment.



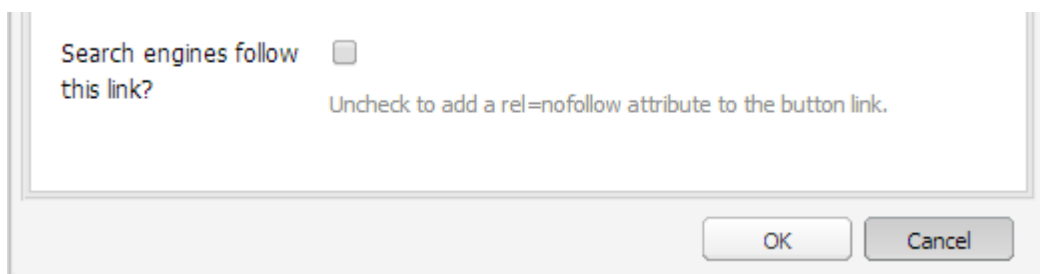
12. Choose an icon from the dropdown.



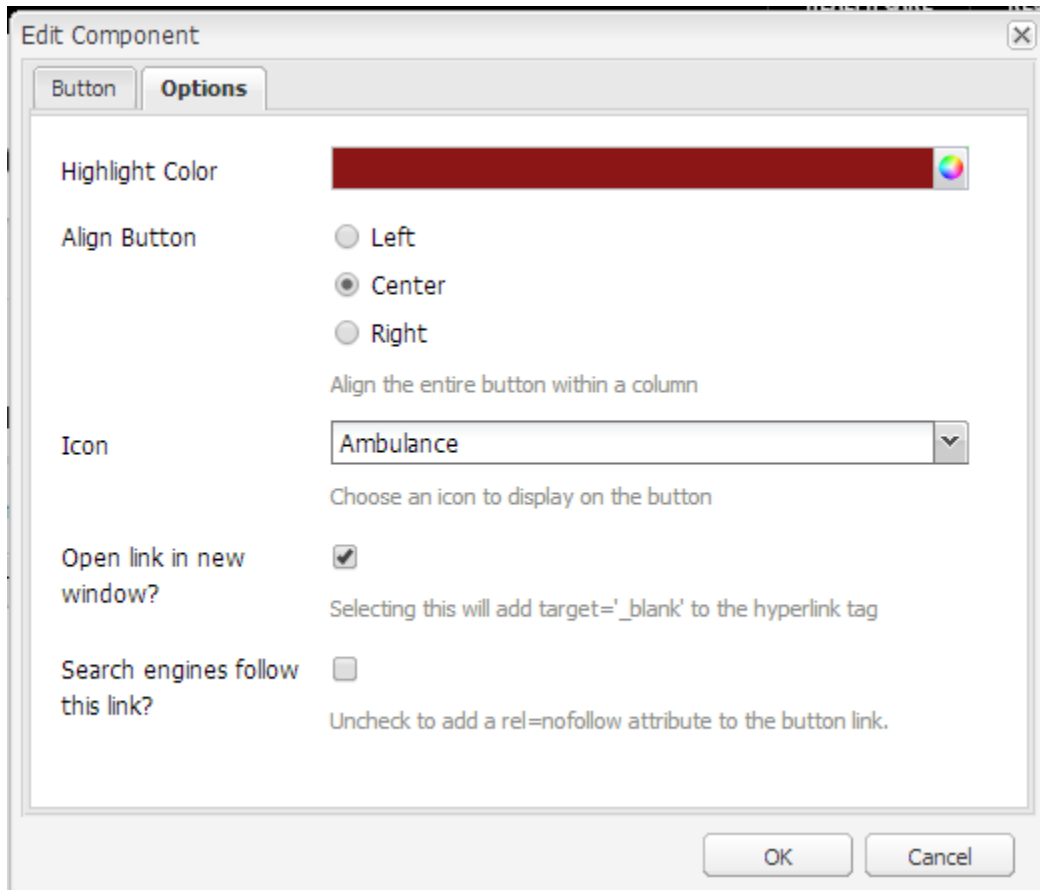
13. To open in a new window check the box.
