

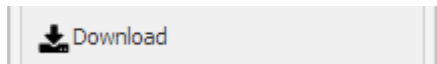
Download Link Component

Description of Component

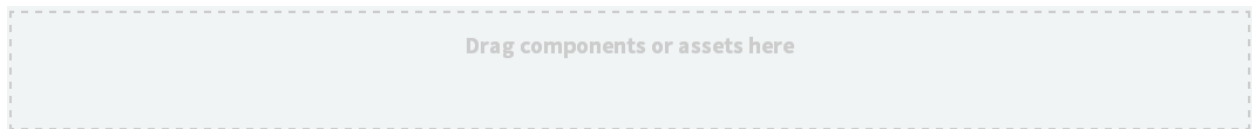
The Download Link component visually enhances a web page by adding an icon that denotes the link downloads a file versus simply being a hyperlink on a page. The icon separates a download link from a simple hyperlink on the page making it easier for site visitors to know what is a link to content or another page and what is a link to a downloadable file.

How to Use the Component

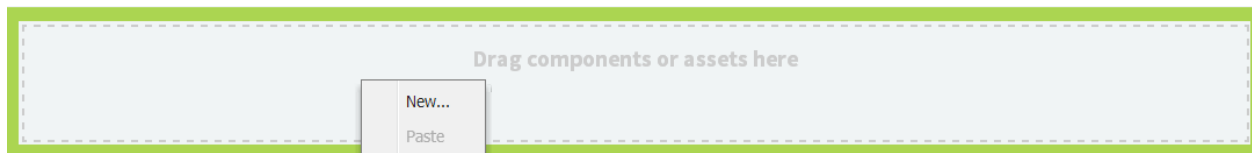
1. You can identify the Heading in the Web Author toolkit as follows:



2. Drag the component onto the page in the place where you want the text to display.



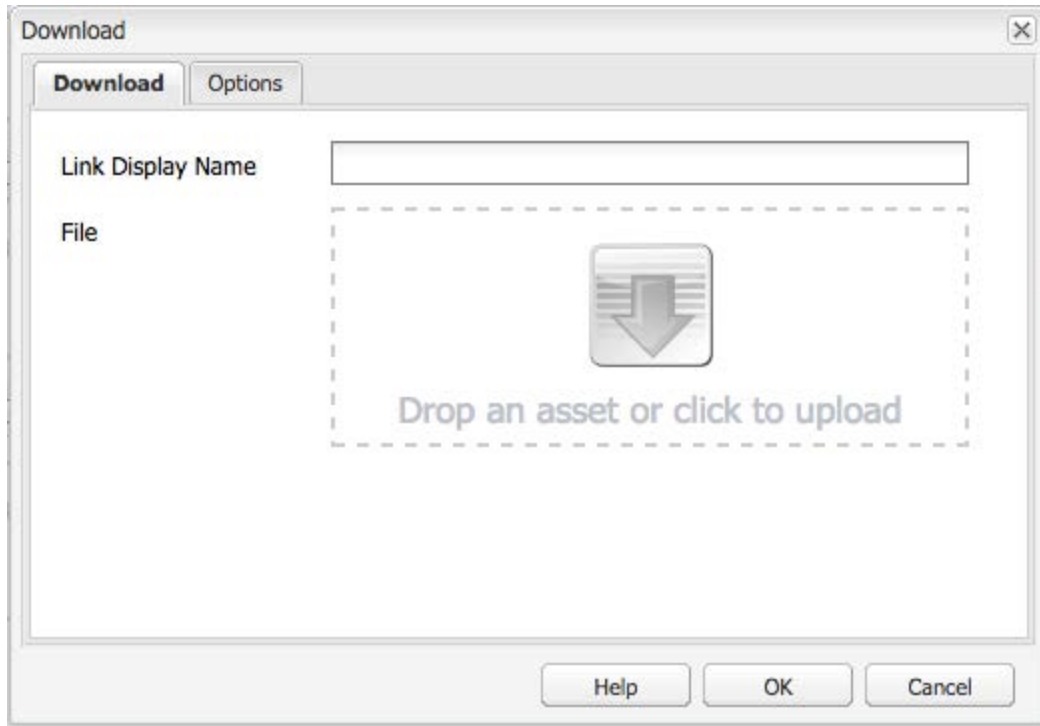
3. Or, right click and select New.



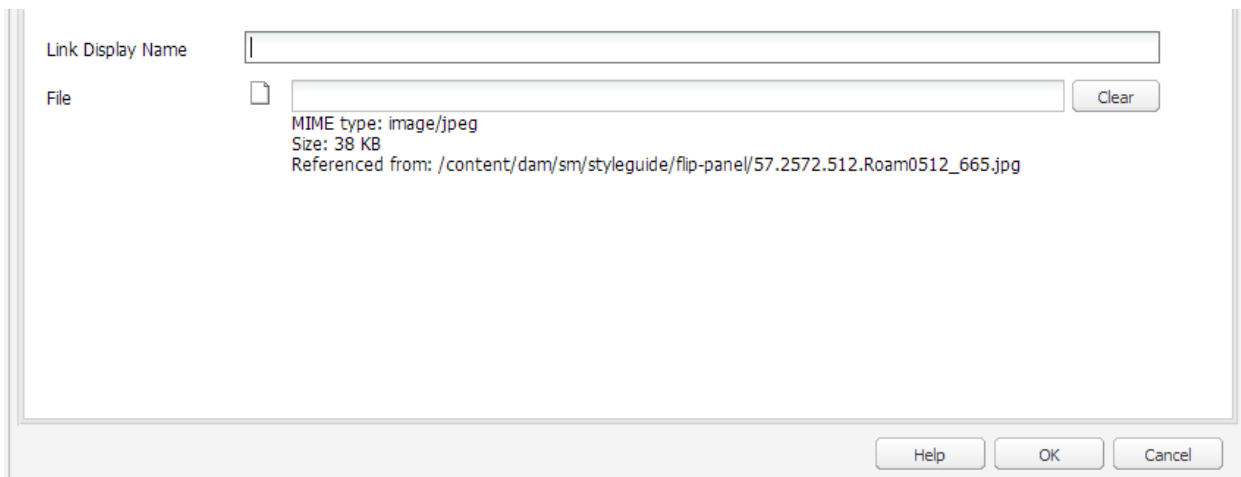
The component displays the download icon.



4. Double click or right click to open the component to edit it.



5. Drag a file from the Content Finder or click to upload a file from your PC.



6. Type text for the link to display a name.
