

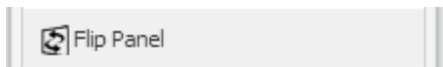
## Flip Panel Component

### Description of Component

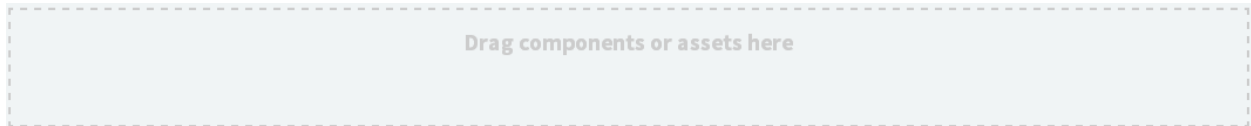
A Flip Panel component is used inside of a Panel Builder component. Flip Panels allow a web author to display content, whether an image, text, Feature Box, etc. on the front of the panel and when a user clicks the icon, the panel flips to display content on the back of the panel.

### How to Use the Component

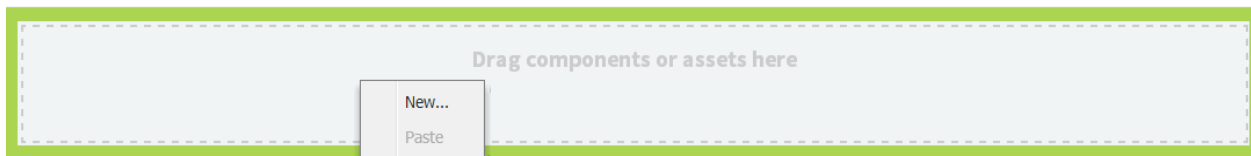
1. You can identify the Flip Panel component in the Web Author toolkit as follows:



2. Drag the component onto the page in the place where you want the text to display.



3. Or, right click and select New.



The component displays on the web page.



4. Drag components into the front of the Flip Panel.
5. Edit the component(s) as needed and be sure to click OK to save the changes.

6. Click the arrows to switch to the back of the Flip Panel.

7. Drag components into the back of the Flip Panel.

8. Edit the component(s) as needed and be sure to click OK to save the changes.
