

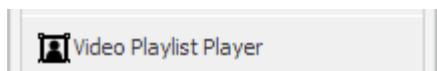
Video Playlist Component

Description of Component

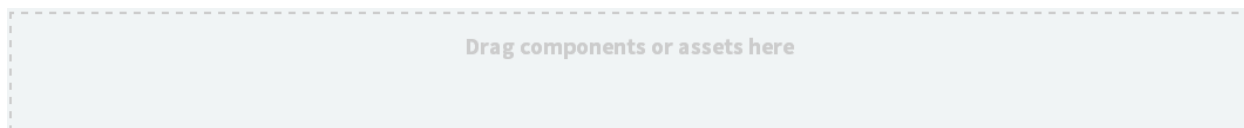
The Video Playlist component is used to display previously created video playlists on a web page. The video playlist allows a web author to grab the video ID from their MediaSpace hosted video playlists and configure the player with customizations.

How to Use the Component

1. You can identify the Video Playlist component in the Web Author toolkit as follows:



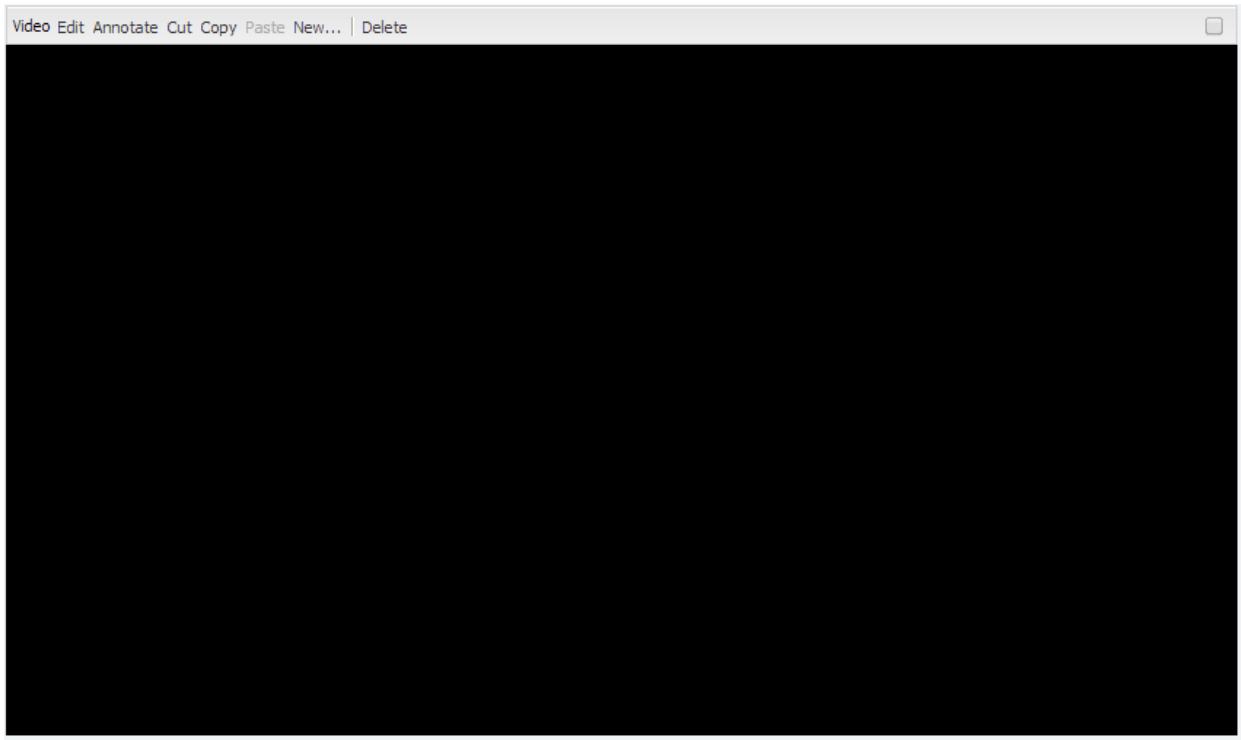
2. Drag the component onto the page in the place where you want the text to display.



3. Or, right click and select New.




The component displays on the web page similar to the example below.



4. Click Edit to bring up the component dialog.

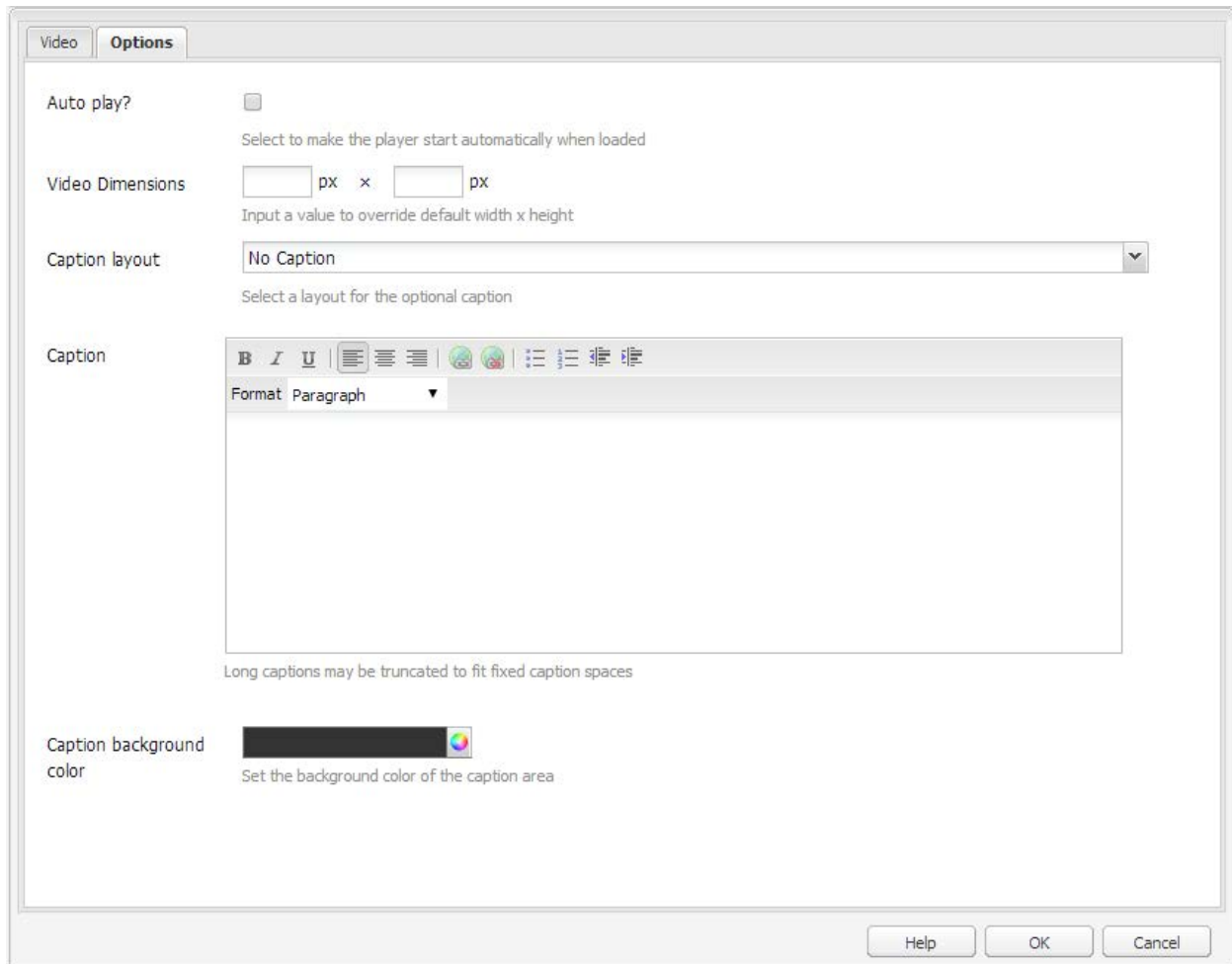
5. Add a Playlist ID in the field.

7. On the Options tab you have the following optional fields you can change.

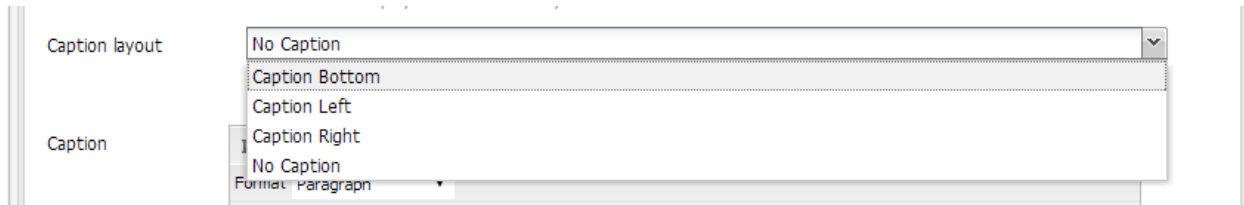


8. Check the Auto play field to have the video play upon page load.

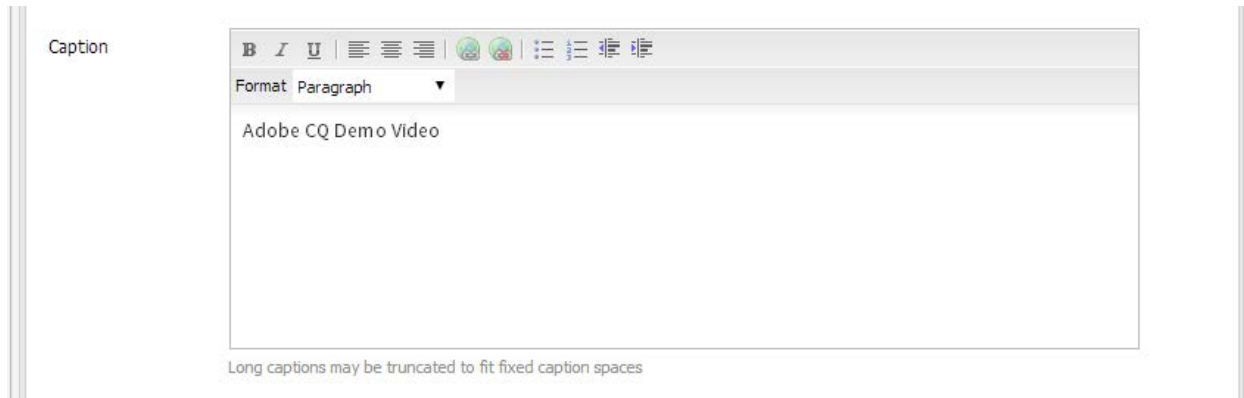
9. Select the Video Dimensions.



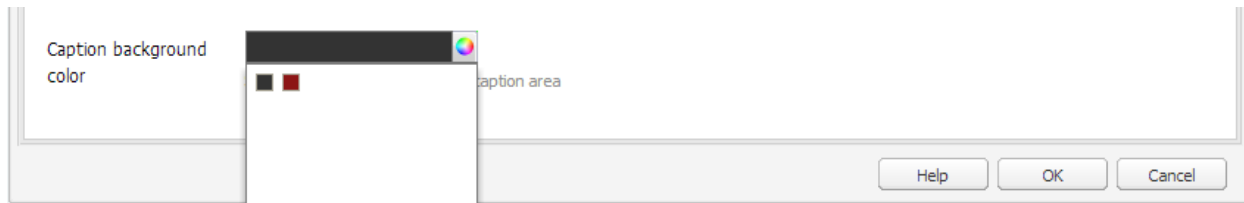
10. To change the caption, click the down arrow to view and select an option.



11. Add caption text.



12. Select the Caption background color.



13. Click OK to save the changes.
