Background

SNF residents highest-risk
DPH prioritized SNF mitigation
e.g. PPE, testing, 1:1 RN coach

Community partners

19 SNFs in SF, including:
SFCJL: 211 beds, 96% MCal
Sequoias SF: 24 bed, Mcare
Victorian: 90 beds, Mcare/Mc

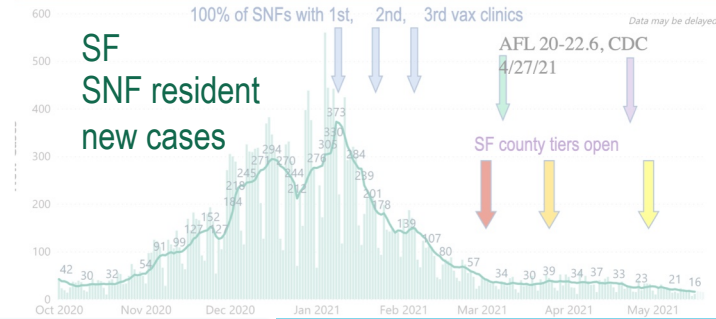

n = 2524 (100%)
Cases 909 (36%)
Deaths 142 (6%)



Outcome

26 participants, 3
major+2 minor themes

8 LLC + 3 for profit (58%)
6 (32%) non-/not-for profit,
2 (11%) county

Lessons/themes per SNFs

1. Develop workforce pipelines
CNA/LVN/RN training, retention
2. Clarify guidance (SF, state, fed)
3. Improve MC/MC reimbursement
4. MH resources for SNF residents
5. Childcare/school for SNF staff

Recommendations

- Connect SNFs & vocational schools, educational incentives retain and develop staff;
- Make guidance relevant/usable
- Share best practices across long-term care facilities & DPH
