

Sarcoid Patient Preparation for Nuclear Medicine:

You can eat a regular lunch prior to 2pm the day before your scan. After 2pm, do NOT eat or drink anything with carbohydrates. You can have only proteins and fats at your regular dinnertime.

After midnight, do NOT eat anything. You can have only plain water up until your scan.

Insulin Dependent Diabetics: If you are insulin dependent, you should schedule your appointment in the early morning and check your glucose levels as you usually do. If that is not possible, then please call and discuss your diabetic control with us.

If you are going to have a separate CT or MRI study, please make sure it is scheduled after your PET/CT scan.
